Worship the Lord for whom He is

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

The Lord is King of kings and you serve Him. Your hearts must be right with the Lord. You cannot be serving Him while your heart is somewhere else or wishing you must have done things otherwise.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for a steadfast heart unto Jesus
- Pray that your mind should not waver
- Pray that your heart depends on God's word

The fear of God unravels the love of God in any believer. Until you begin to fear God, you cannot obey Him. Obedience is the love of God. The fear of God is eroding in our churches today and the love of Jesus Christ is waxing cold in our hearts. How can you fear someone you do not obey? You do not obey Him because you have little regards for Him. How then can you say that you love Jesus?

Let the fear of God grip you today. Examine all that you have from Him including your breath. Reverence the Lord, adore and praise Him.

Pray that the fear of God will fill your heart right now.

EVENING

Brethren, the fear and love of God are in obedience to His word. Do you study the word of God? Do you attend bible studies in your church or you are a 'Sunday Christian'? The word of God is God (John 1:1) and John 1:14 says the word of God is Jesus Christ. If you do not know the word of God, you cannot know Jesus. If the word does not abide in you, you cannot discern the devil. Obedience of the word is the love of God that will cause you to walk in His ways. If you love (obey) Jesus, God Himself will love you.

Pray that God will birth obedience in your heart today henceforth

As a believer, it is of utmost importance that you focus on the One you believe in. John 6:28-29 declares "Then said they unto Him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on Him whom hath sent." If you believe in Jesus, then you must focus on Him by faith daily. When Peter was focused on Jesus, he walked on the water; but as soon as his focus left Christ and rather went to the waves, he began to sink.

PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God to give you the grace to be focused on Him
- Pray against distractions
- Pray for stability so that your mind will not waver

As your mind is fixed on the Lord, you become a surrendered vessel depending completely on His power. Psalm 46:10a declares "Be still and know that I am God." The phrase 'be still' comes from the Hebrew word 'raphah' which means 'to let go', 'to release'. Therefore, you and I are called to depend on God.

PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God to teach you to let go
- Pray against the spirit of doubt
- Pray that you remain faithful to the Lord
- Pray for confidence in God's word and power

PRAYER POINTS

- Check the condition of your heart. Is your heart right with God?

- Pray for pride to leave your heart

Brethren, obedience leads to righteousness. Righteousness is right standing with God. Brokenness ushers in righteousness. Psalm 51:17 declares, "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, Thou wilt not despise."

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that you will walk in righteousness always before God
- Pray that the Spirit of God will perpetually lead you in paths of righteousness
- Pray that even where temptation is at its maximum, let God strengthen you to withstand it
- Pray that you will stay as a living sacrifice to God

DAY 6

MORNING

As you read in the gospel of Luke 11:1, the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray. A wonderful information is also released in this verse, that John taught his disciples how to pray. So, we must be teachable, especially on how to pray. Only prayer can keep you away from temptations of the world. The flesh or our fallen nature will also cause you not to pray. But you must do all you can to pray without ceasing. It is prayer that causes God to hear you. It doesn't matter how anointed and gifted you are with mountain top faith, without prayer you will remain stagnant. Prayer causes God to show mighty things you have never known.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for the spirit of prayer
- Ask God to cause you to pray without ceasing
- Ask God to take away the power of the flesh in you
- Pray against the spirit of heaviness
- Pray for the zeal to intercede for the saints

Fasting causes prayer to move in fullness of its power. Prayer is much more powerful when the soul and body are subjected to the spirit. 1 Corinthians 6:17 declares, "he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit." When your thoughts, decisions and actions are in line with the word of God, then you operate in the spirit. You then begin to pray without ceasing because you are in God's presence. So, fasting enables you to walk in the spirit and desire not

the things of the flesh.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that God will enable you to fast
- Pray that God will enable you live a fasting life
- Pray that fasting should not be a burden to you
- Pray that God will always sustain your fast to the end
- Pray against gluttony

DAY 7

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Judges 20:1-20, 35

1 Kings 21:23-29

1 Samuel 30:8-12

Esther 3:8-10; 4:11-16; 5:2-6

Judges 19:1, 22-30; 20:1-20, 35

Brethren, there are at least seven types of fasts recorded in the bible.

- 1) One day fast for spiritual reexamination and consecration
- 2) One day fast for uplifting judgment
- 3) One day fast for unanswered prayer
- 4) Three days dry fast for crisis
- 5) Three days dry fast for healing
- 6) Twenty-one days dry fast for revelation
- 7) Forty days fast for dominion

One day fast for spiritual reexamination and consecration

It is possible for you to stay in a one day fast weekly. In this fast, you are able to examine and consecrate yourself weekly to God. You can get into another one day fast weekly so that your prayers are answered. In Luke18:12, Pharisees in their worship to God fasted twice a week. This weekly practice actually empowers your prayer life.

One day fast for uplifting judgment

A one day fast for the upliftment of judgment could be done when you have wronged God and it keeps worrying your mind even after repentance. Ahab wronged God after his wife Jezebel arranged for Nabod's murder for him to take his inheritance. When punishment from God was pronounced by Elijah, he humbled himself before God, fasted that day and repented and God uplifted that judgment to the reign of Ahab's son.

One day fast for unanswered prayer

A Levite went to fetch his concubine and got to Gibeah which belongs to Benjamin and certain sons of belial went into the house where this man and his concubine resided. The owner of the house begged them to allow the man but gave them his daughter and the man's concubine. These rascals defiled them until the Levite's concubine died and the Levite cut the woman's flesh in bits. The Levite on arrival to Israel tabled the matter and the children of Israel solicited the Benjamites to bring out the culprits but they did not respond. The children of Israel went to seek God's counsel as to who will go to battle with the Benjamites (v18 of Judges 20). And the Lord said Judah should go and the children of Israel were badly beaten (v21). In v23, the children of Israel went again to seek God's counsel, weeping before God and asked if they should go fight or not. God said that they should go. In v25, the Benjamites again destroyed 18,000 people of the Israelites. The v26 says, "Then all the children and people went up to the house of God and fasted that day until evening and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the Lord. And in v28, the children of Israel inquired of the Lord if they should go against the Benjamites or not. God changed the language saying, "Go up; for tomorrow I will deliver them into thine hand."

So, because the children of Israel fasted that day to evening, God also accepted their offering and their prayer was answered.

Three days dry fast for crisis

A three-day dry fast for crisis is normal practice in the life of a believer. When your family or loved ones are threatened with death, please behave like Esther. Stay for 3 days without food and water and the results will be obvious liberty.

· Three days dry fast for healing

This type of fast will not heal arthritis, growths, cancer etc. but will remove toxins from the body. In 1 Samuel 30:11-12, David's men found an Egyptian in the field who had been abandoned by his master. They gave him food and

when he had eaten, he was revived and his spirit came back to him. For he had not eaten for three days and three nights.

PRAYER POINTS

• Pray that God should enable you live a fasting life

EVENING

• Twenty-one day fast - Daniel fast

The 21 days fast is a partial fast in which you eat fruits, nuts and vegetables. The purpose of this fast is for revelation. If you intend to know anything from God concerning whatsoever, get into this fast. It is a fast worth practicing yearly or as desired. There is also a 40 day fast for dominion. Moses dominated Egypt. Elijah dominated Israel and Jesus is still dominating the earth and the universe. The 40 day fast must be specifically led by the Spirit of God.

PRAYER POINTS

- Continue to pray that God should empower you to live a fasting life
- Pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit

DAY 8

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Genesis 20:1-7

Psalms 25:21

Proverbs 11:3

1 Kings 9:4

1 Corinthians 4:18-20

Integrity is defined as the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles or moral uprightness. Moral uprightness keeps you from falling into diverse sins. Good character is established.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that God should give you strong morals
- Pray against fornication and adultery
- Pray against being moved by any type of doctrine
- Pray for steadfastness. Let your 'Yes' be 'Yes' and your 'No' be 'No'.
- Pray against cheating as a way of life

EVENING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Galatians 5:22-24

The fruit of the spirit is the result of obedience to the word of God. Integrity, which is the love of God, produces the fruit of the spirit. Jesus Christ says in John 6:63b "The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life." The words that you obey come into you, change your ways and your new ways are what is described as the fruit of the spirit (Word). The fruit is manifested externally by good morals or character. Humility is the visible sign (not pretence).

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for each of these: love, joy, peace, longsuffering (perseverance), gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and temperance (self-control).
- Pray for good sense of judgment

Try to examine yourself if some of the above manifest in you.

DAY 9

MORNING

Brethren, it is amazing how much believers tend to be scared of the devil. To the extent that it seems Jesus is absent in our lives or as if we are not the temple of God. Fear of the devil is eroding our faith in the Lord. 1 John 4:18 declares "there is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear; because fear hath torment."

We must remember always that God is a God of hosts. Heavenly hosts are His. God created all things, the visible and invisible. He created the angelic. You must feel secured as a believer. Angels have never stopped worshipping Jesus who is in you.

Pray that fear of the devil should leave you

Satan is an angel made by God but now a fallen one and cannot be more powerful than God his creator. Romans 8:15 says "for you have not received the spirit of bondage (slavery) again to fear"

Pray against fear

EVENING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Hebrews 1:13-14

Zechariah 3:1-2

Daniel 3:14-29

Isaiah 37:33-37

Be conscious of angels all around you and know that they will manifest as you pray to God. You personally have absolutely no control over angels but the word of God does. Do not ever forget that angels follow after the word of God (Psalm 103:20).

Pray for boldness

2 Timothy 1:7 says "For God has not given us the spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Mark 11:21-24

Luke 10:17-21

Matthew 9:2-8

The power of God is with you. The presence of God carries the power of God. The presence of God is His person; the power of God is the manifestations. The presence of God may walk away from you leaving the power because the power is a gift. The presence of God left Saul but he remained king of Israel. Samson still had the power but the presence was absent (Judges 17:20). He died with the Philistines (Judges 17:18-30). Seek the power of God for 1 Thessalonians 1:5 says "for our gospel came not unto you in word only but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance." The power of God is by faith; desire it today in prayer.

• Ask for it in your life. The Holy Spirit is with you.

EVENING

Exercise the power of God today. Pray and decree whatsoever and it will happen. As you worship and pray, all that you have asked or desired will come to pass. Speak with conviction and assurance in this prayer.

Brethren, as you grow mature in the word of God and exercise faith in the word, power begins to grow. How much of it is by grace

• Pray that the power of God will be released in an unprecedented manner the world over.

In the past ten days, you have moved from the things of the world (flesh) and now you are hiding in the Lord. The Lord being your hiding place protects you spiritually and physically. So, please stay in the hedge (fence). Do not go out! There are snakes out there.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for God's protection over your life
- Pray for His protection over your spouses, children and loved ones. Call their names one by one if possible.
- Pray that God will give you the strength to stay in intercession for your family

(Please take time to read all carefully)

God Almighty does not only protect, He prospers us in protection. 1 Peter 3:12a declares, "For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous and His ears are open unto their prayer." Though He has given all these precious promises, you must ask in prayer.

PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God for divine vision on what to do and write down the vision clearly
- Pray for wisdom to execute the vision
- Pray for your ongoing projects at hand
- Ask God for divine helpers
- Ask for whatever you need today

DAY 12

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Hebrews 11:1-5, 6 (take note of verse 6)

Brothers and sisters in the Lord, faith is the vehicle through which God accomplishes His promises to you. The apostles said unto our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, "Increase our faith" (Luke 17:5). Without faith you can never please God (Hebrews 11:6). Now, Jesus is the author and finisher of our faith (Hebrews 12:2). As we keep trusting Him, our faith grows (Romans 1:17).

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for an increase in faith
- Ask God to keep your eyes focused on Jesus
- Ask God to increase your interest in the word of God daily
- Pray that your faith fails not

Prayer is communication between you and God. You may have all the armour of God and the gifts of the Spirit, but without prayer, they cannot manifest. It is a sin not to pray. Prayer therefore is outstanding in our walk with the Lord. We are commanded to ask in prayer, seek in prayer and knock in prayer; which are different routes in the different kinds of prayer. Only prayer will bring you answers from God through faith.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for the spirit of prayer
- Pray that God will increase your desire to pray
- Pray that your prayer will produce results
- Pray that your prayers will not be hindered

DAY 13

MORNING

It is important this day to note that there is always a waiting period after praying and giving to God. Patience is a virtue that births experience. Tribulations and discouragements will come but Jesus says that he who endures unto the end will be saved (Mark 13:13). This waiting period builds hope in you for hope is the anchor of our souls (Hebrews 6:19). Hope is divine expectation. Never pray and sow without expecting. Always expect from the Lord.

EVENING

Jesus patiently endured the cross, despising the shame and the pain, to get to the throne of His Father. Those with great ambitions usually go through this.

PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God for a fresh outpour of the anointing upon pastors to take them to the next level

- Pray for revelation of the Word in them to preach the Word with power

- Pray that God should raise teachers of the Word of God
- Pray that pastors should be committed to God in studies and to their followers
- Pray that pastors will move out of their comfort zones and spread the Word of God
- Pray that God will arrest and raise new pastors

EVENING

Brethren, it is important to commend or speak well of our pastors and pray for their shortcomings instead of speaking ill of them. 2 Corinthians 12:11 declares "I have become a fool in glorying (praising myself); ye have compelled me to: for I ought to have been commended of you..." There is a blessing for commending your pastor to men and in prayer, you commend him to God and God will in turn also commend you in your desires.

Some genuine pastors have fallen prey for prophecy, signs and wonders from the power of darkness.

PRAYER POINTS

The mind is the battlefield for spiritual warfare. Although we live in the world, we are not of the world and our battles are not carnal but spiritual. Most of what happens in the physical is determined by the spiritual. If we have to be successful, we must therefore engage in spiritual warfare, otherwise, the evil one will always have his way into our lives, fulfilling John 10:10a which declares, "The thief cometh not but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy." The warfare is on your knees (prayer), with all other armours of God – truth, righteousness, gospel of peace, faith, salvation and the word of God; as conditions that give you a mighty protective standing in Christ, enabling you to fight through prayer. Prayer produces the offensive and the armour of God gives the defensive in warfare. The word of God remains the cartridge, and prayer the gun. By these, strongholds are pulled down and freedom and liberty obtained.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for the development of the armour of God in you.
- Pray against every stronghold in your mind that doesn't glorify God to be cast down.
- Pray that the knowledge of God and of Jesus Christ abound in your life.

DAY 17

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Psalm 119:89, 105, 160, 162

Jeremiah 15:16

Isaiah 40:8; 55:11

Matthew 24:35

John 1:1, 14

Hebrews 4:12

The entire scripture points to the Messiah who is the word of God. The word of God never fails, never fades, never changes, but can change all things.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that the word of God will cover the earth like the waters cover the sea.
- Pray that God will raise mighty teachers of the word and prophets who will download the mind of God by the word to all.
- Pray that God will manifest His word wherever the word is dispersed.
- Let the Holy Spirit through the word of God convict lost souls and change the hearts of men.

EVENING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Isaiah 11:2

"And the spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord."

There are seven manifestations of the Holy Spirit in this verse. They are all revealed through the word of God:

- 1. The spirit of the Lord
- 2. The spirit of wisdom
- 3. The spirit of understanding
- 4. The spirit of counsel
- 5. The spirit of might
- 6. The spirit of knowledge
- 7. The spirit of the fear of the Lord

All these will manifest in your life or ministry when you are soaked in the word of God.

- Spirit of the Lord is the acceptance of the Lordship of Jesus Christ over your life by obedience to the word of God.
- Spirit of wisdom is the enablement to apply the word of God in any given circumstance.
- Spirit of understanding is the revelation of the outcome of the word of God (wisdom) applied to a circumstance.
- Spirit of counsel is the power to speak the word of God in advice to any situation.
- Spirit of might is the supernatural force that goes with the word of counsel.

- Spirit of knowledge is the revelation of whom God and His Son Jesus Christ is.
- Spirit of the fear of the Lord arises after the knowledge of whom the Godhead is.

All these are wrapped up in the word of God which has been entrusted to you and I, not to angels.

PRAYER POINTS

Pray for the daily revelation of the word of God in you.

Please read the chapter in the bible e.g. John 15. Read it again. Look at keywords and know their meaning, see the meaning and message in the sentence. See yourself in the action. Apply what you have learnt in that chapter.

N/B: The chapter may carry two or three ideas or thoughts.

DAY 18

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

Romans 12:8

As of today, I believe your obedience and love of Jesus Christ has resulted to the flow of God's love in your life. At this point, God Almighty begins to trust you with the manifest gifts of the Spirit – work of wisdom, word of knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, working of miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, divers kinds of tongues, interpretation of tongues. God entrusts these gifts in bits, and it grows as you remain obedient and patient with Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour. There are more gifts of the Spirit as follows – counsel, giving, leadership, acts of mercy - All these are yours.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that God releases these gifts to you.
- Pray that the gifts should increase in your life.
- Pray that God will birth patience in your life.
- Pray that God will birth obedience in your heart.

EVENING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Ephesians 4:7-13

Brethren, God Almighty may decide to lift you from a follower to a servant. Jesus declares many are called but few are chosen – Matthew 22:14. You could be feeling right now to serve God and desire one or all these offices of an Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor or Teacher. Paul declares in 1 Corinthians 14:1 "follow after charity and desire spiritual gifts..."

If this is your desire, please lift up your hands and pray this prayer:

Father God Almighty, today I hand myself: spirit, soul and body, as a living sacrifice unto You, for Your use. Lord, there is nothing I desire in this world other than to serve You. Use me Lord. I surrender all to You. Help me walk according to Your will. Father, I am all Yours in Your vineyard for the rest of my life in the name of Jesus. Amen.

DAY 19

MORNING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Exodus 15:26

Psalm 103:2-3

Psalm 107:19-20

Isaiah 53:5

Matthew 12:21-22

Luke 8:11

James 5:16

Mark 5:28-34

In Luke 10:19, Jesus says, "Behold I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall by any means hurt you." Healing is also the bread of the children (Matthew 15:22-28), and in John 14:12, Jesus declares "Verily, verily I say unto you, he

that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than this shall he do; because I go unto my Father."

Brethren, the same Spirit that raised Jesus Christ from the dead dwells in you (Romans 8:11). Therefore, the same power of the Holy Spirit is also with you.

PRAYER POINTS

Please by faith:

- Pray for anyone sick of terminal diseases such as:
 - 1. Cancer of all kinds 2. Kidney failure 3. Heart failures 4. HIV/AIDS 5. Diabetes 6. Insanity.
 - If you know anyone sick of these diseases, please mention their names as you pray.
- Pray against the spirit of infirmity in your family, community and country.
 - Please take time to pray because plagues may be hitting areas of the world.
- Pray for good health for all of the saints in the body of Christ.

EVENING

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Mark 1:21-27, 32-34

Mark 5:1-17

It is important to let you know that you are able to cast out devils by the same power Jesus Christ our Lord cast them out with. Only believe that you can do it and have no doubt in your heart.

Pray for those possessed or oppressed.

Take authority over the demonic and loose the affected person. Then command the devil to come out of the person (Please read Mark 5:1-17 carefully).

Take note of the following remarks:

- 1. Devils are cast out by the power of His word (Matthew 8:16).
- 2. Conversation with evil spirits is not a doctrine because the gospel agrees with itself. Deuteronomy 19:15 and 2 Corinthians 13:1 say, in the mouth of two or three witnesses, every matter is established. Matthew 8:23-24, Mark 5:7-18 and Luke 8:26-36 are all accounts of an

act, and the word of God expressed in no other place in the New or Old Testaments.

Secondly, Jesus had warned His followers to be careful with what they hear.

Thirdly, I believe Jesus did this to expose the characteristics of demons.

- Demons are bodiless creatures and so they live in bodies.
- They can be in any number in a body.
- Demons agree.
- Demons can transfer from one body to another.
- Demons control or take over the minds and actions of the possessed etc.

Read John 8:44. That is the Lord Jesus' position about the devil. How then would you do otherwise? Sometimes, some ministers of God actually carry out conversation with demons in possessed or oppressed people and believers take what they (demons) say for truth, and that qualify the minister as great. Whereas, Jesus called the devil a liar and he is the father of all lies. Can truth come from the devil? Judge for yourself.

So, as you pray casting out devils, when they begin to speak through the person, see it as a distraction and keep praying in the name of Jesus and they will leave completely.

But if you fall into conversation with them, you weaken ministering angels because you are listening and believing a lie. As you weaken the power of the divine angelic, these demons go ahead and trick you sometimes saying "I have left" and knock the person on the floor making you to believe that they have gone out of him. They do not leave, but only hide and will come again later. This explains why many deliverances conducted are never complete and people are delivered year in year out. We cannot get deep into this now.

DAY 20 MORNING

Worship the Lord

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Exodus 20:5 Jeremiah 31:29-32 2 Kings 5:25-27 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 Matthew 8:13 Proverbs 18:21 Ephesians 6:10-18 Luke 10:19

Brethren, please this day is for deep family reflection. Look out for the things which have been recurrent in your family. Things which happened to your mom or dad, or grandma and granddad; which are also happening to you, your siblings, uncles, aunties, cousins, nephews and nieces. These similar occurrences are described as 'generational'. It could be the manner in which people die, particular illnesses or happenings. It all happens in a pattern. The origin of these could be from: (1) what our forefathers believed in and worshipped (2) what our parents covenanted with (3) could be a curse from within or from out of the family because of a wrong act or quarrel or misunderstanding. All these give rise to sufferings, limitations and hopelessness.

Deliverance from such circumstances begins from your total surrender to the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ who is the embodiment of deliverance. His presence in your life is enough to liberate you and help you liberate your family. Secondly, your thoughts must be that of victory so that your faith becomes active and not dormant. Your talk must never be faithless; otherwise, you will be weakening the angels on assignment. Thirdly, believe in the power of the eternal blood of Jesus; and fourthly, trust in the power of the Holy Spirit in you and also in the word of God. You notice that deliverance begins from the mind – if you do not see yourself free, how would you remove others from bondage? You must see yourself free in Christ Jesus and then pray against demonic powers over your life and that of your family.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that God should cause you to surrender completely to Jesus Christ, helping you to put down all your defenses (ego, connections, positions, wealth, beauty etc. Everything that makes you tough in your eyes).
- Pray for active faith that will move whatever is not of God.
- Pray for a release of the power of God in you.
- Pray that the blood of Jesus and the word of God be alive to you.
- Ask God to enable you know that you are free because Jesus has set you free from sin and condemnation. You are no more under sin, so you are not condemned. You are free by the grace of God.

• Ask the Lord to enable you effectively break these generational curses because of covenants of old which have brought sufferings, limitations and hopelessness in the family.

EVENING

Worship the Lord

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Isaiah 49:24-26

Psalm 22:3

2 Chronicles 20:20-22

Deliverance from generational curses is done first by worship and prayer. (Family) prayer could be corporate i.e. many people gather or individual.

PRAYER POINTS

- 1. Praise God for what He has done and what He is about to do in your family.
- 2. Worship God for whom He is.
- 3. 1 and 2 bring His tangible presence. You may be so moved and begin to cry uncontrollably. Please hold yourself that you may speak in His presence. Anger against sin may also come but still hold yourself.
- 4. Ask God to forgive the sins of your family.
- 5. Now, start speaking in prayer with confidence.
 - * Tearing and breaking down strongholds.
 - * Casting out every strong man in your family.
 - * Take authority over every demonic power plaguing the family.
 - * Break every yoke of the dark and bondages.

Now, start to loose your family from the high places of principalities and power.

- * Loose their destinies
- * Loose them from the spirit of infirmity if they are sick
- * In 3 5, you could plead the blood of Jesus and call on the fire of the Holy Spirit.

- 6. Now, begin to ask for total restoration of self and family. Here, you could ask for specific things, especially breakthrough.
- 7. Begin to thank God for answered prayers. Worship Him again, blessing His holy name.
- 8. Sometimes, you may make a vow to God or sometimes with a grateful heart and show of love, you generously give to God.

Brethren, this is not a fast rule but it will help you as this is from years of experience and effective application of the above.

A frequently asked question is "How can one maintain deliverance?" The answer is:

- 1. Stay in the word of God
- 2. Prayer and fasting
- 3. Worship
- 4. Live a righteous life
- 5. Points 1 4 will keep demons away from you. Even if they come, they will have nothing in you, for sin cannot hold you down. Sin is the power of death without sin, the devil cannot get hold of you.

DAY 21

MORNING

Worship the Lord

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Numbers 13:26-33

Jeremiah 1:9-10

Take a total mind review of your whole life: where you are coming from, where you are today and where you want to be tomorrow. See yourself where you want to be tomorrow, confirm it with the Holy Ghost and thank God for establishing it.

PRAYER POINTS

- Thank God for establishing your destiny.
- Thank God for protecting you.
- Ask God for His perpetual presence.
- Ask Him for daily revelation in your life.

• Ask Him to guide you daily.

EVENING

Worship the Lord

SCRIPTURAL READINGS

Psalm 103:1-2

1 Chronicles 29:11-12

Exodus 15:11

Revelation 4:11; 7:12

Offer to God a sacrifice of praise. Worship Him from the depth of your being in thanksgiving with the fruit of your lips.

The end of this fast is with a communion service at 6pm. Please have a piece of bread and red juice wherever you are in the world to partake.
